Agitating Over First Amendment

Protesters from the We the People Foundation hold a right-to-petition vigil in Lafayette Square in front of the White House. The protesters donned costumes and depicted a scene from "V for Vendetta," a film based on a comic series set in a dystopian, totalitarian Britain. The protesters stood in "peaceful defiance of despotism, awaiting a response for our petitions for redress."
